Requirements for Confirmation

Confirmation:

The Sacrament of Confirmation seals our Baptism and confirms our commitment both to the Church and to the Word of Christ in the world.

Youth Confirmation (High School age)

The Confirmation journey is a sacramental preparation process for high school student's grades 9-12. The process has a flexible meeting schedule that responds to the ever-changing needs of the students.

The preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation is a one-year program.

Adult Confirmation

If you are a baptized Catholic and are 22 years old or older and have never been confirmed or you have been baptized and raised in a Christian faith, preparation classes are also available, and the process is also one year long.

Requirements:

- Be at least 15 years old by the time of confirmation
- Present the baptismal and first communion certificates (if you have received the sacraments) at the time of registration.
- Non-refundable donation is \$70.00 per person, and should be paid at the time of registration. If you are requesting two sacraments the donation is \$75.00, and if you are requesting three sacraments the donation is \$80.00.
- Spanish classes for those candidates between the ages of 15-22 are on Tuesdays from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Franciscan Hall.
- Spanish classes for those over 22 years of age are on Wednesday from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Franciscan Hall.
- English classes are on Fridays from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Franciscan Hall.
- Candidates are required to do 40 hours of community service at the parish.
- If you are planning to take a vacation or a long time off, please consider taking the course in the future.
- You may need to buy extra material during the course.
- Classes start on time, and doors will be closed, unless you notify the instructor in advance.
- Only three absences are allowed. After three absences you will be asked to take the course again.

- Required materials: a notebook, a journal, a Bible, a pen.
